

Recency of Professional Teaching Practice for Renewal of Full Registration

A teacher applying for renewal of Full registration under Section 51 of the Act must have completed 20 days of professional teaching practice to maintain their eligibility for Full registration. TQI recognises that maintaining currency of professional teaching practice is a contributor to teacher quality.



This requirement can be met by fully registered teachers working for a minimum of 20 days a year in one, or any combination of, the following:

- Working in an approved school in Australia or New Zealand
- Assessing student participation in a government endorsed education service
- Administering government endorsed education services which relate directly to the *Australian Professional Standards for Teachers* or *Australian Professional Standard for Principals* or directly influences the content and practice of teaching in Australia or New Zealand.



Teachers with Full registration who are unable to meet the annual 20 days professional practice requirement may be able to apply to renew their registration and be asked to outline their circumstances in the renewal application.



These Professional Practice requirements do not apply to:

- Provisionally registered teachers
- Permit to teach.
