

# Pre-Service Teacher Register

The Pre-service Teacher Register is administered by the Teacher Quality Institute and is unique across Australian jurisdictions. Inclusion on the register marks a key milestone in the pre-service teacher pathway and provides a sense of belonging to the teaching profession.

## Phase 1



From January 2020 all initial teacher education (ITE) students undertaking a professional experience placement in an ACT school are required to be on the Pre-Service Teacher Register.



Inclusion on the register indicates to principals that the ITE student has valid *Working with Vulnerable People* registration or equivalent and is eligible to undertake a professional experience placement in an ACT school.



A searchable register of pre-service teachers is available to principals.

## Phase 2

(In development)



When phase 2 development is completed approved pre-service teachers will have access to the TQI portal, resources, PL opportunities and ability to update each placement on the portal.
